

Maritime Single Window (MSW)



- Maritime Single Window (MSW) mandatory as from 2024
- Guidelines for setting up a Maritime Single Window
- IMO Compendium on Facilitation and Electronic Business (IMO Compendium)
 - IMO Reference Model
 - IMO Data Set
- Symposium Maritime Single Window 2024, Hybrid, 18-19 January 2023
- eLearning Course on Maritime Single Window



IMO Compendium



- Approved at FAL 43 in July 2019
- Including a representation-independent <u>data model</u> and a <u>data element list</u>
- Covering the reporting requirements defined in the FAL Convention
- Interoperability



Partnership Agreement



- Why: Importance of digitalization of information exchanges
- When: signed on <u>2 March 2020</u>
- Who: IMO, WCO, UNECE and ISO
- What: Cooperation on the maintenance of the IMO Reference Data Model













Partnership Agreement (Cont.)



Areas of Cooperation:


- Cooperate to maintain the IMO Reference Data Model
- Create and maintain the implementation of the IMO Reference Data Model,
 - WCO Data Model
 - UN Core Component Library (UN/CCL)
 - ISO 28005 series of standards (ISO/TC 8)
- Have the possibility to raise change requests to the IMO Reference Data Model
- Participate in the "IMO Expert Group on Data Harmonization"
- Designate experts with the maintenance of the electronic version of the IMO
 Compendium and the IMO Reference Data Model



IMO Expert Group on Data Harmonization (EGDH)



- Approved at FAL 43
- Two meetings per year
- Volunteer work
- EGDH 9 will take place on 23-27 October 2023 at IMO Headquarters, London
 - UNECE will sponsor the document "Maintenance of the IMO Compendium on Facilitation and Electronic Business"
 - UNECE will not support the document "Proposed Definitions of API and Related Concepts"
