







30th Anniversary of Asia-Pacific Urban Forums (1993-2023)



- APUF is the longest standing regional multistakeholder urban forum globally
- Mandate: A decision from the 1994 Commission Session first agreed the Asia-Pacific Urban Forum should be convened periodically which was followed by:
- Resolution 70/12 (2014) on Strengthening efforts on human settlements and sustainable urban development for the Asia-Pacific region
- Resolution 79/7 (2023) on Advancing regional cooperation for sustainable urban development and localization of the Sustainable Development Goals in Asia and the Pacific

Alignment with key events and urban processes, 2023-2024



- Outcomes of Subregional urban forums (i.e. Pacific) and national urban forums (Philippines, Lao PDR, etc.) to feed into APUF-8
- SDG 11 under review globally in 2023
- 12th World Urban Forum and Summit of the Future in 2024








Focus and Expected Outcomes

- Engaging diverse stakeholders: A High-Level segment of ministers and senior
 officials responsible for urban portfolios; five stakeholder assembly sessions for
 local and regional governments, civil society, women, youth and business
- ESCAP / UN-Habitat flagship report, 'Crisis Resilient Urban Futures for Asia and the Pacific'
- Voluntary commitments of stakeholders on sustainable urban development
- Regional messages to upcoming milestones in 2024: 12th World Urban Forum,
 APFSD11 and CED-8
- Strengthening the existing platforms in support of localization of SDGs



Participation and Associated events

Over 35 high level speakers confirmed, including ministers, mayors, governors and CEOs 2,000 + participants in Suwon 919 international registrations (as of 15 Aug)
