Part 1: development of ToR of JWG



- The draft ToR has been prepared by TC154 and UNECE.
- Since last Nov, TC154/CAG and UNECE have a meeting every month to develop the draft ToR.
- The first version of ToR was officially circulated as N1378 and TC154 has launched a CIB for comments and approval. The voting result can be found in N1384 and comments from SCC were received, and the disposition of comments received can be found in N1396.
- Based on the comments received disposition in N1396, the updated ToR was finalized as N1397 and approved by the ISO/TC154 side.
- On 7 Sep 2023, UNECE officially confirmed the Terms of Reference (ToRs) finalized in N1397 on the joint activities between UNECE and ISO TC/154 via email.
- N1397 is the final version ToR and approved by TC154 and UNECE.
- Question: ToR for ISO 7372(TDED) (J)MA in N998 approved by TC154 and UNECE was circulated in 2018, what is the procedure to cancel or withdraw it?

- As pre the voting result in N1412, JWG9 is established from ISO/TC154 side with the title" information exchange of supply chain aligned to UN/CEFACT semantics" and the scope" Development and maintenance of standards for supply chain aligned to UN/CEFACT semantics. Excluded standards related to EDIFACT-Syntax (JWG1)", and ISO 7372 is assigned to JWG9.
- On 3 Oct 2023, UNECE officially confirmed to establish JWG9 via email.
- Co-conveners for JWG9 need to be nominated accordingly in this plenary meeting.

Part 2: main content of ToR

Terms of Reference (ToR) on Joint Working Group(s) between UNECE and ISO/TC 154

- 1. Introduction: introduce the background to draft the ToR
- 2. Objectives: improve the joint collaborative activities, in line with the ISO/IEC Directives and the UN/CEFACT Policies, Procedures, the technical principles requirements and the project management procedures in the JWG
- 3. Scope: ToR governs activities under JWG(s), and these activities cover all tasks performed in JWG(s) in the development of any type of deliverable.
- 4. Governance Structure: nomination of (co-)convener
- 5. Participation: UNECE experts, P-members and A-liaison of TC154
- 6. Technical Principles: decisions concerning JWG(s) between UNECE and TC154, way of collaboration, etc,
- 7. Projects Management: Project Leadership, Project Procedure,
- 8. Exemptions from the technical principle and procedure: how to deal with an exemption
- 9. Project Cancellation: the procedure on a project cancellation
- 10. Closing the JWG(s): the procedure on closing the JWG
- 11. Disputes: if disputes happen, final decision for any dispute shall be made between ISO/CS and UNECE.
