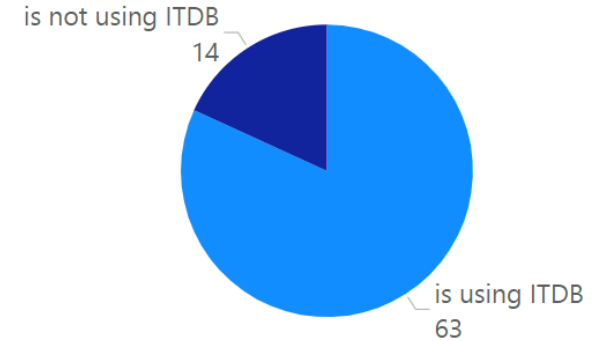

General ITDB data status

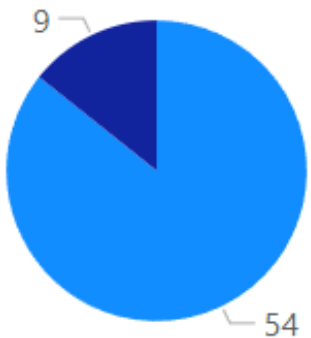
- 1,156 web application users *(since 2018)* -14

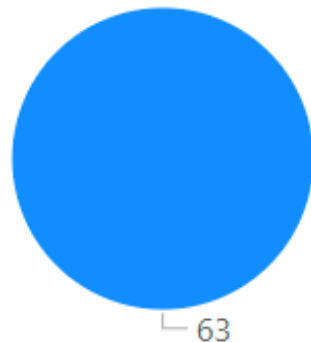
Contracting Parties with ITDB users since 2018



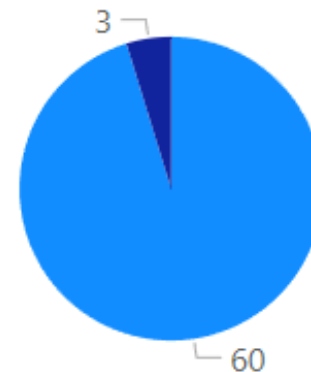
Active Contracting Parties with holder data



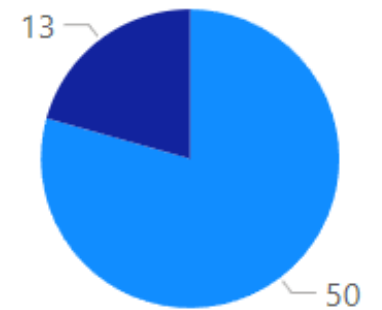
Active Contracting Parties with Customs or Nat. Associations users

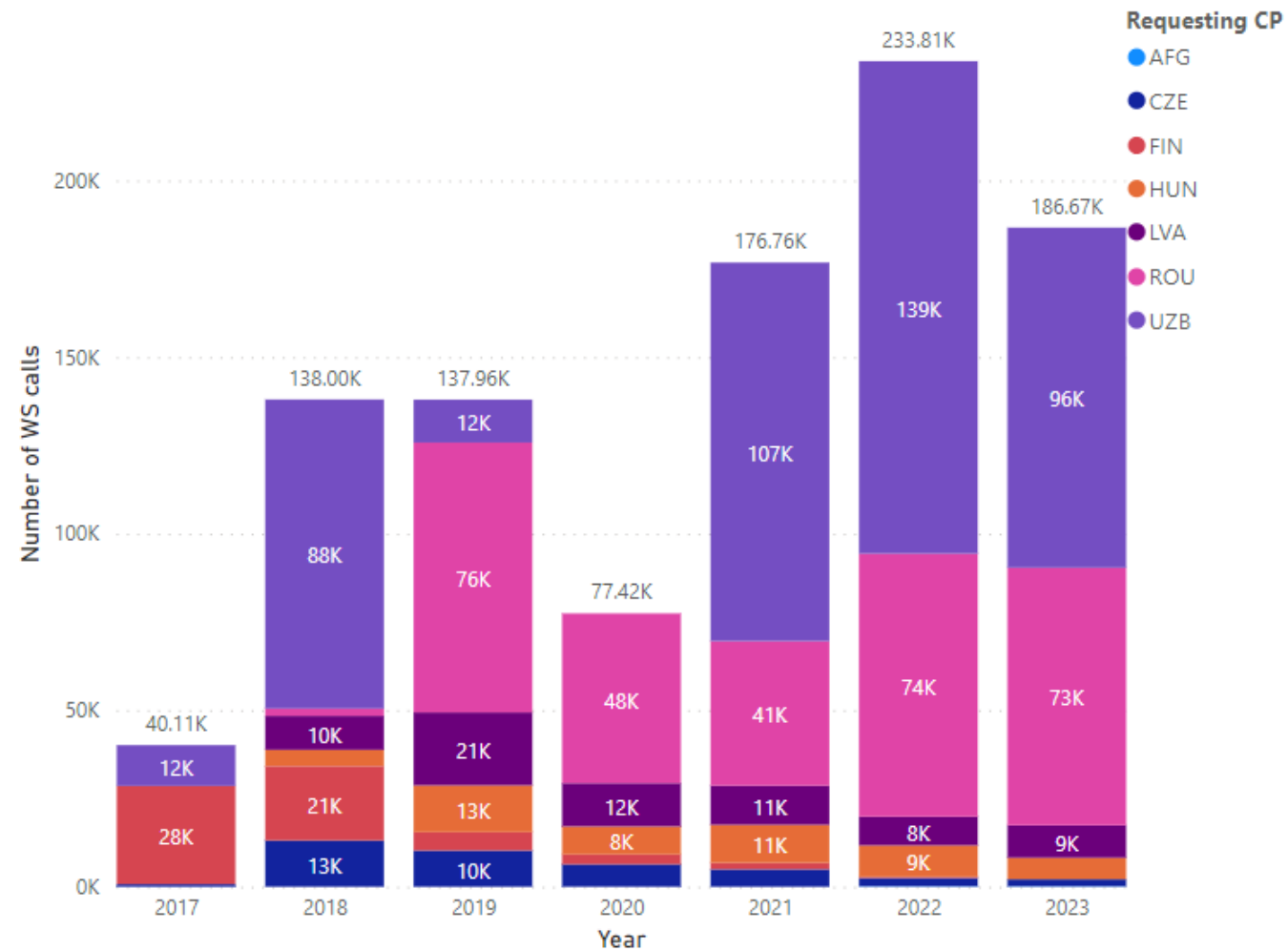

ITDB web service status

- Approximately 138,000 web service calls per year in 2018 and 2019
 - 77,700 WS calls in 2020
 - 176,710 WS calls in 2021
 - 233,740 WS calls in 2022
 - 186,670 WS calls so far in 2023
- *Current trend similar to 2022*

Recent achievements

- Focus on eTIR National Application project implementation
 - Implementation completed at 95%
 - Test completed at 90%
 - Addition of Kazak, Kyrgyz and Persian language support

Future releases and other activities planned by end 2023

- Finalize eTIR NA project and focus on first deployments
- As before:
 - Continue supporting eTIR Mobile users
 - Extend eTIR Portal and ITDB languages
 - Continue supporting contracting parties in customs office data import
 - Support conformance tests (ITDB data import/updates)
