

- CAREC program, the which Under envisages the use of an alternative digital transit system as an analogue to the NCTS, a draft Memorandum of Understanding between the customs authorities of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Georgia, and the of Uzbekistan Republic the on implementation of the CAREC Enhanced Transit System (ETS) and Common Information Exchange (CIE) was developed with financial support from the Asian Development Bank.
- This system, like the NCTS, provides for preliminary exchange of information on the route of transportation, introduction of electronic transit documents, and customs guarantees.











Trans-Caspian international Middle Corridor


eTIR



- TIR Convention, Annex 11, adopted on May 25, 2021.
- On June 3, 2022, a protocol was signed between the State Customs Committee of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Azerbaijan International Road Carriers Association on additions to the "Guarantee Agreement for TIR Instructions" (In order to recognize the electronic guarantee).
- On December 26, 2022 for the first time electronic TIR (eTIR) transit transportation in accordance with the Customs Convention on the International Transport of Goods under Cover of TIR Carnets (TIR Convention) was carried out between Uzbekistan and Azerbaijan.

The information system of the SCC of the Republic of Azerbaijan is connected to the eTIR international transit system.

The system will become fully operational after other countries join it.





