



• Data coverage (Y2009-Y2021) and latest available year








## 1.1.1 - Employed population below international poverty line

• Employed population below international poverty line, both sexes, age 25+ (%)














### 10.2.1 - Proportion of people living below 50 per cent of median income

- More countries with recent data from Y2020-Y2021 for indicator 10.2.1
- Major update to the global database expected towards end of December 2023
