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The revision of the Norwegian targets set - 1

- We set our first targets in 2014
- We have worked to revise these targets according to the developments that have occurred since then. We also have a draft cross-sectoral implementation plan drawn up related to our revised targets.
- Established two working groups: at both directorate and ministerial level
- The UNECEs “Guidelines on the setting of targets, evaluation of progress and reporting under the Protocol on Water and Health” has been used actively in the preparation of the Norwegian targets.
- Stakeholder involvement: Norwegian Water (a national association representing Norway’s water industry) and the Norwegian Association for Local and Regional authorities



The revision of the Norwegian targets set - 2

- The revised targets and its implementation plan will probably be published around new year.
- Examples of suggested targets that includes climate-sensitive issues:
 - Target 5: *“Municipal social planning must ensure citizens safe drinking water and drinking water considerations must be taken care of in spatial planning”*
 - Target 6: *“The municipalities shall have comprehensive plans and measures that sees water, sanitation and land-planning in context.”*
 - Target 11: *“The municipalities overall risk and vulnerability analyses shall ensure the safety of the drinking water supply systems.”*
