





This course presents the **Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road** (ADR), its advantages, scope implementation methods at national levels through relevant stakeholders, and the necessary documentation and legal issues related to it. It also aims to provide useful information to the contracting parties to **ADR** during the implementation process.

This course is intended for experts and legal advisers in transport ministries and departments, as well as for other relevant ministries (e.g., environment, interior, foreign affairs), presidential administrations and national parliaments in **countries interested in becoming contracting parties to ADR** as well as in countries already applying **ADR**.
