

GOVERNANCE AND DIPLOMACY

- The Botswana Vision 2036 works towards insuring “prosperity for all”. The national development plan is aligned to the vision pillars (**WATER IS THE FACILITATOR OF ALL ECONOMIC SECTORS**)
- The National Development Plan 11 (NDP 11: 2017-2023) and the Second Transitional National Development Plan (TNDP 2 : 2023-2025) emphasizes the implementation of Integrated management and optimal utilization of natural resources. In order to ensure environmental sustainability, climate Change mitigation and adaptation are implemented during NDP 11 (**WATER COMES AT THE TOP OF GOVERNMENT DEVELOPMENT AGENDA: TAKE THE BIGGEST SHARE OF NDP**)
- Botswana Economic Transformation and Recovery Plan (ERTP); If successfully implemented, the ERTP will assist Botswana to stimulate economic activity and improve economic growth, the ERTP will be able to also address some of the long-lasting issues impeding economic development and growth in Botswana. Issues relating to the declining rate of economic growth, a deteriorating fiscal position, the need to diversify exports and the economy, uncertainties around the diamond industry’s future and high unemployment.
- The Government of Botswana instituted a Reset Agenda comprised of 5 priorities; saving Botswana Population from COVID 19, Reforming the Public Service, Digitalization, Value Chain Development and Mind-Set Change
- The National Frameworks are aligned to Global blueprint in the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the African Union's Continental Agenda 2063
