






### **Trade facilitation implementation in SPECA countries**


• SPECA achieved subregional implementation rate of 66% (similar level to the Asia-Pacific regional average of 67%), but varies considerably between countries





# Implementation of different sub-groups of trade facilitation measures by SPECA countries


"Digital Trade Facilitation" implementation improved over the years, but still lagging behind.





# Implementation of different sub-groups of trade facilitation measures by SPECA countries

Significant progress in measures related to 'trade facilitation in times of crisis and pandemic' and 'women in trade facilitation'





# **Expected trade cost reduction from alternative trade facilitation reforms**

Trade digitalization can help to significantly reduce trade costs by over 15%.

# Supporting the Digital TF: Framework Agreement on the Facilitation of Cross-Border Paperless Trade in Asia and the Pacific (CPTA)

- A UN Treaty: enabling and action-oriented
  - ✓ Open to interested (53) ESCAP member states (voluntary) to become parties
- **Objective** 
  - ✓ To <u>facilitate</u> cross-border paperless trade (data exchange) among willing ESCAP member states by providing a dedicated intergovernmental framework to develop legal and technical






