PNRR - Mission 2 - Component 4 - Investment 3.1 "Protection and enhancement of urban and extra-urban green areas"

- The PNRR is a performance-based program, where the EU transfers predefined financial tranches based on the satisfactory achievement of milestones and targets, not on expenditure levels.
- The 10 PNRR installments are predetermined with the European Commission, considering successful milestone and target attainment, not spending levels.
- The EC evaluates the PNRR and Operational Agreements to ensure that the objectives are met.
- Forestation targets have passed EC evaluation and EPC/EFC approval, with additional checks ensuring compliance with EU and national regulations for financial protection







