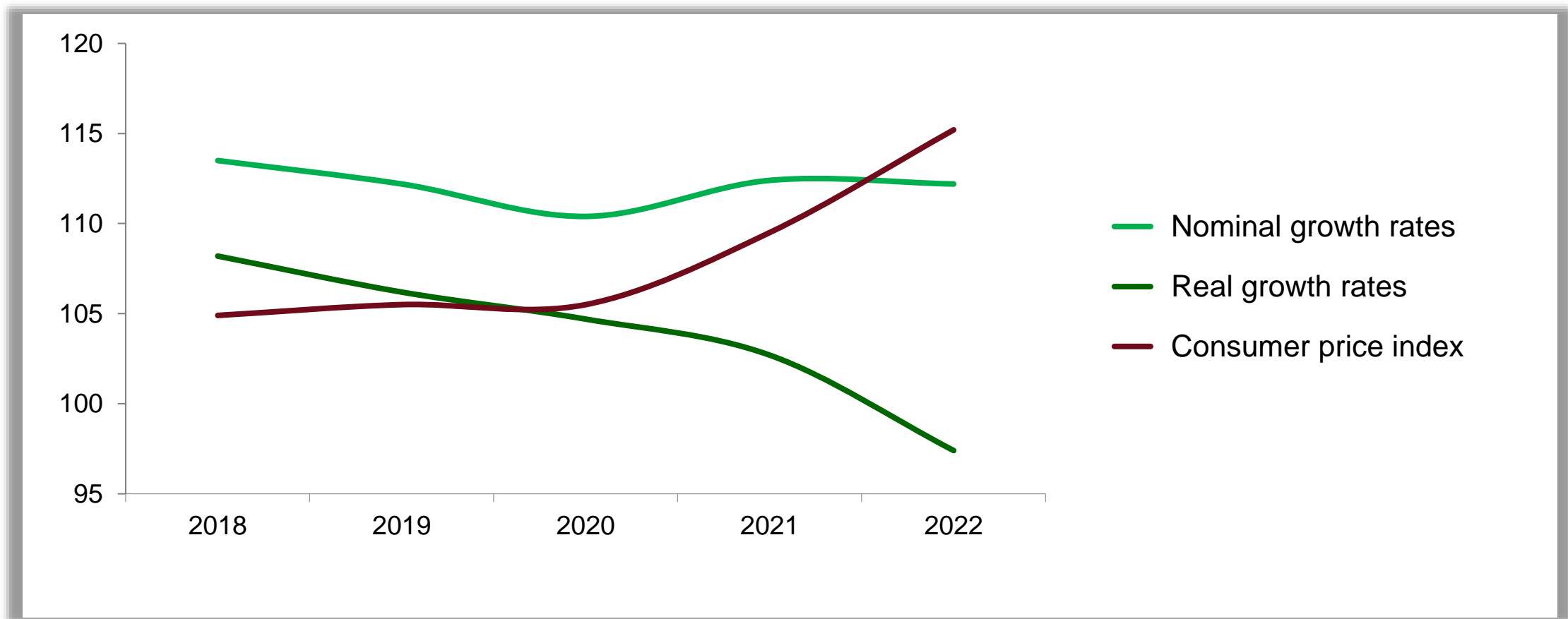

(% of the previous year)





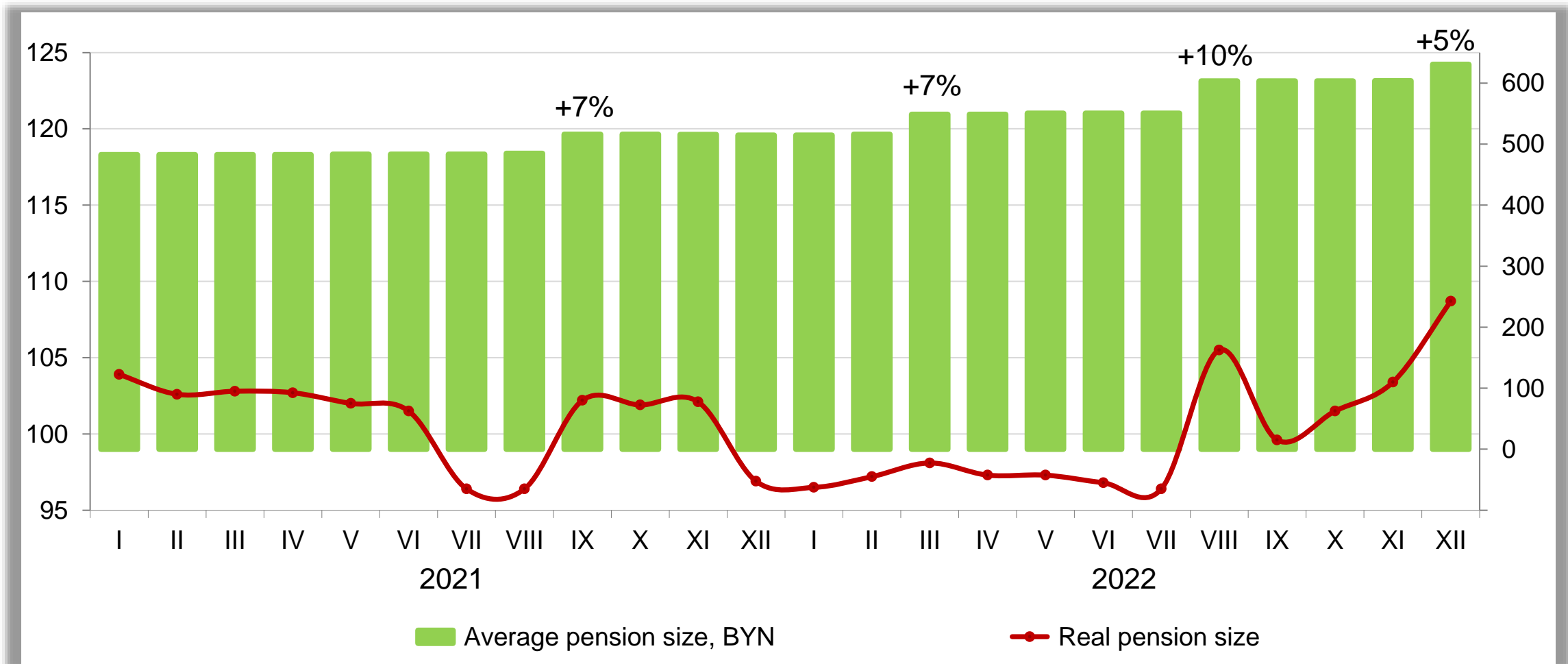
▶ **Anti-inflationary measures**

- ✓ Increase in the minimum wage
- ✓ Indexation of wages and salaries
- ✓ Increase of social payments to the population (pensions, allowances, scholarships)
- ✓ Limiting price increases for socially important goods
- ✓ Providing a discount on certain groups of goods for vulnerable population groups

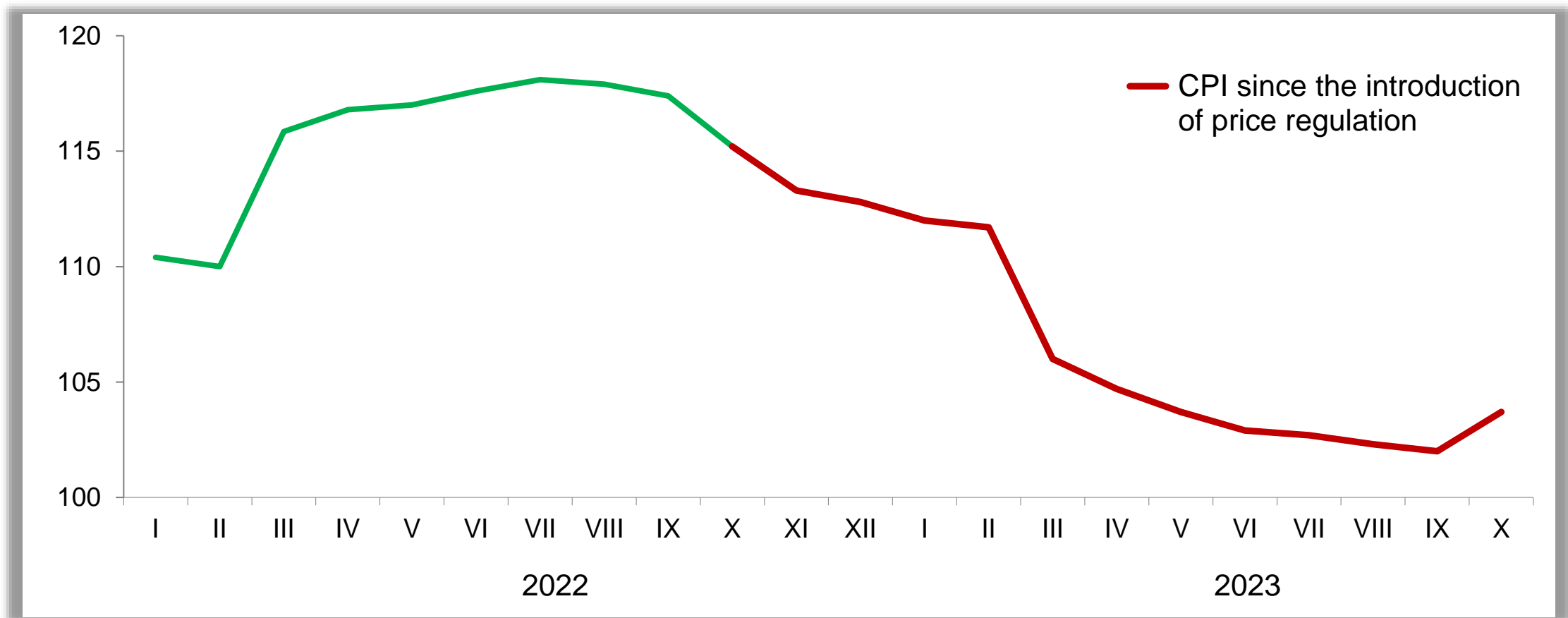
(% of the corresponding month of the previous year)

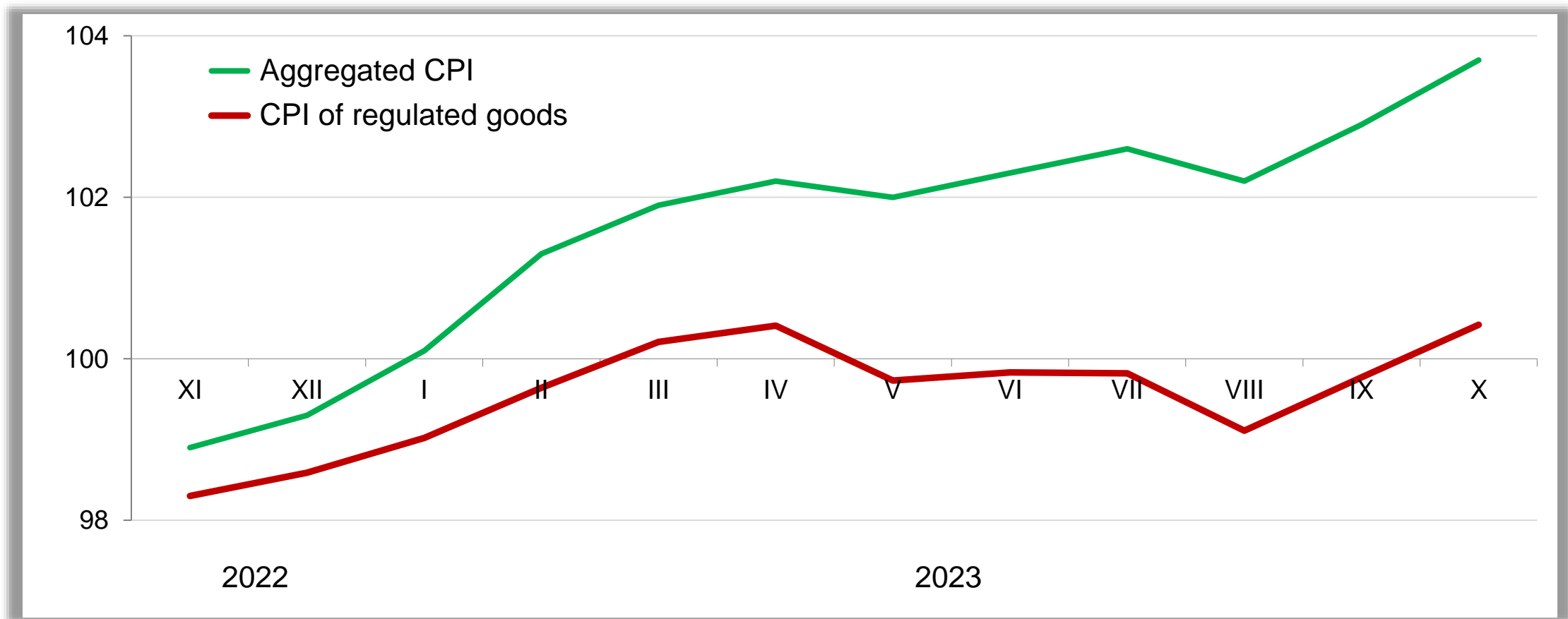
(% of the corresponding month of the previous year)





► Price trend in 2022-2023

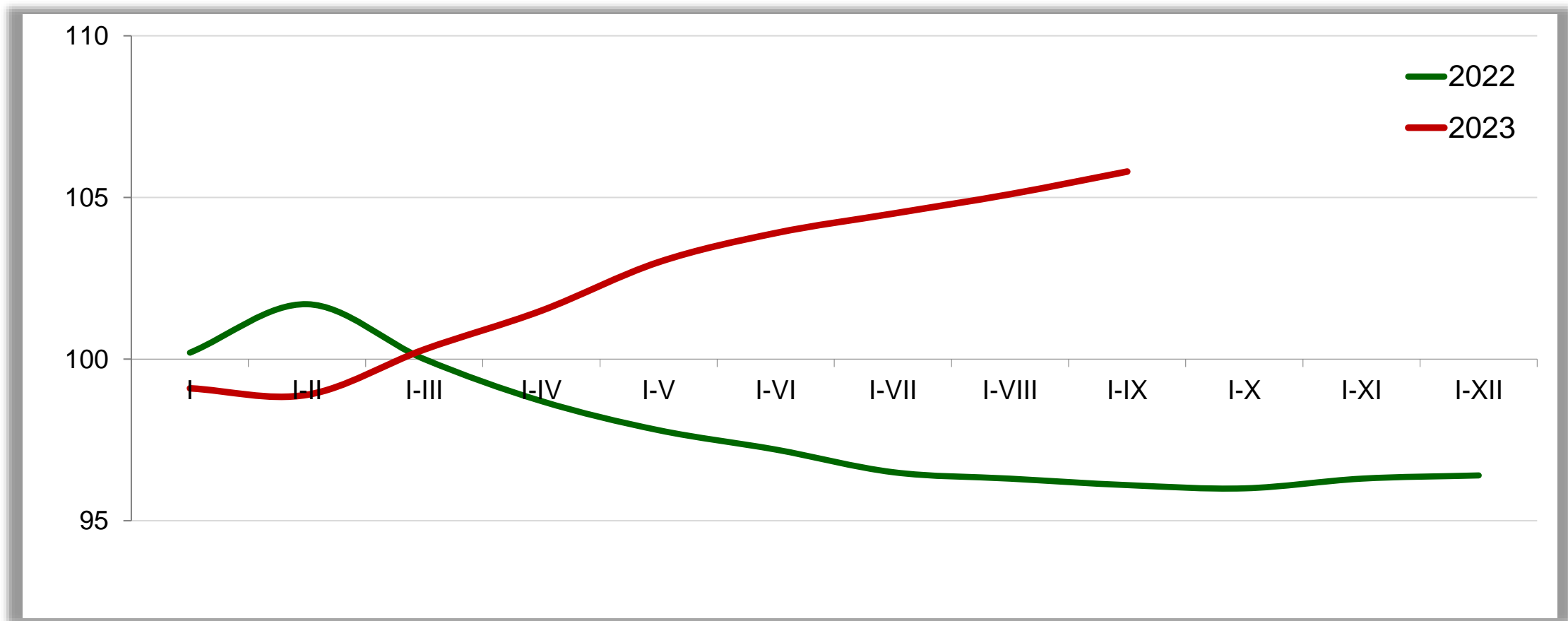
(% of October 2022)





► Real money income of the population

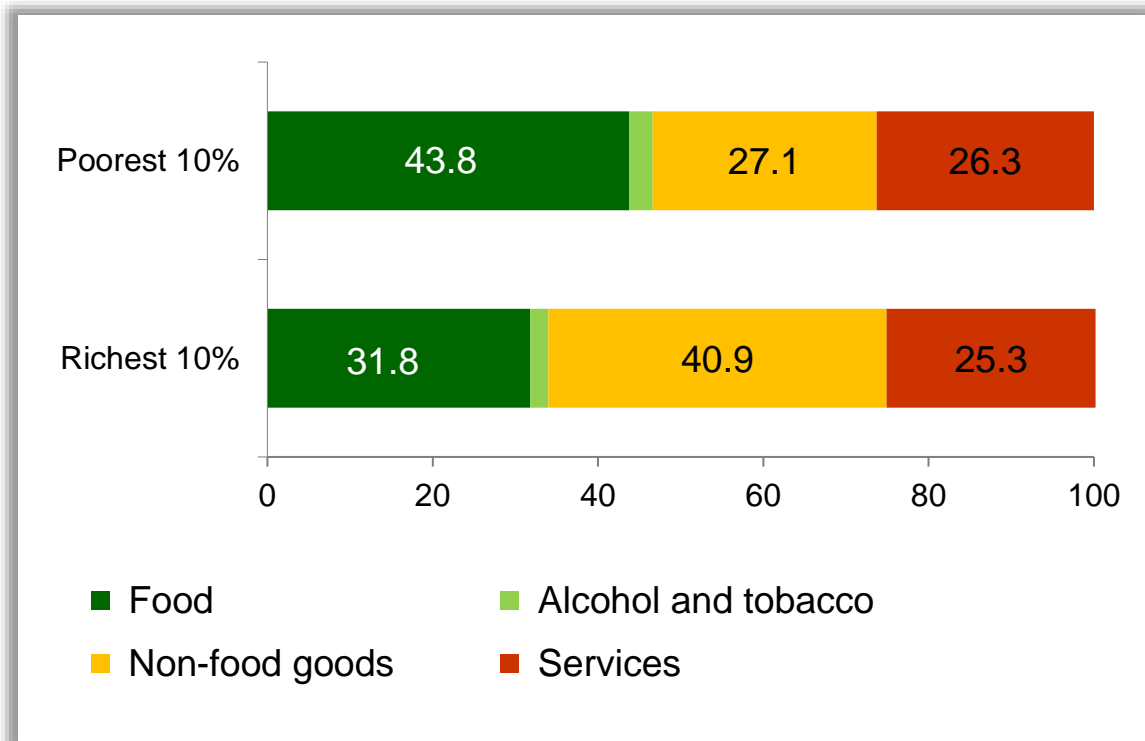
(% of the corresponding period of the previous year)





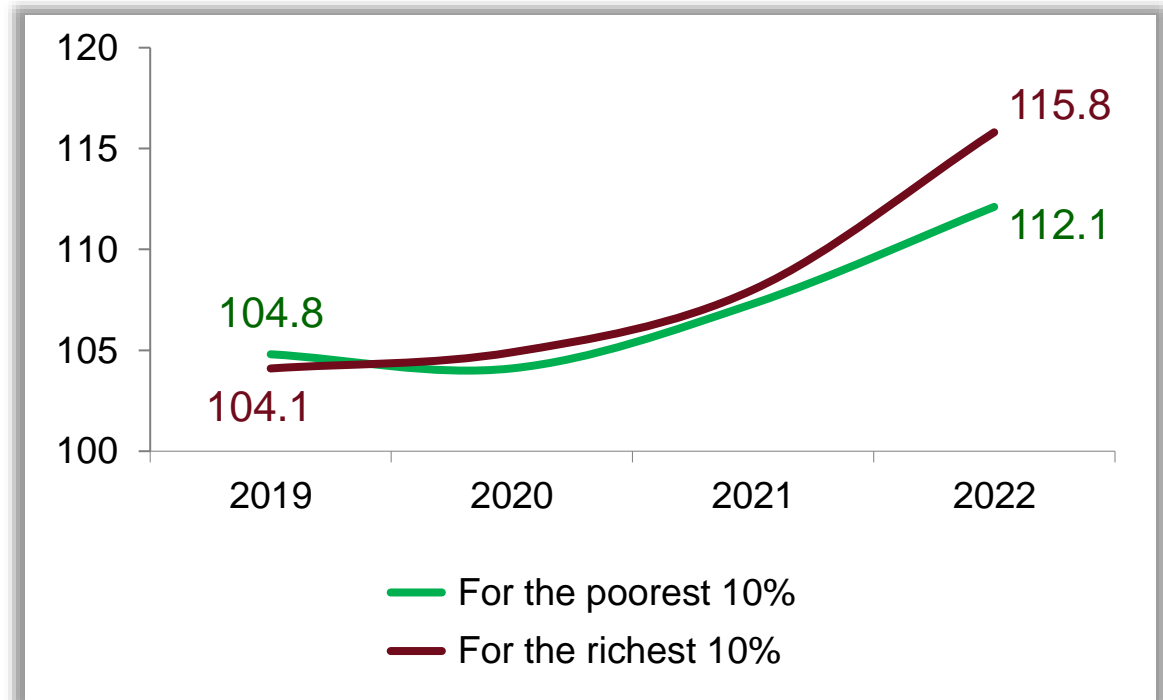
Structure of household consumption expenditure in 2022

CPI for different income groups

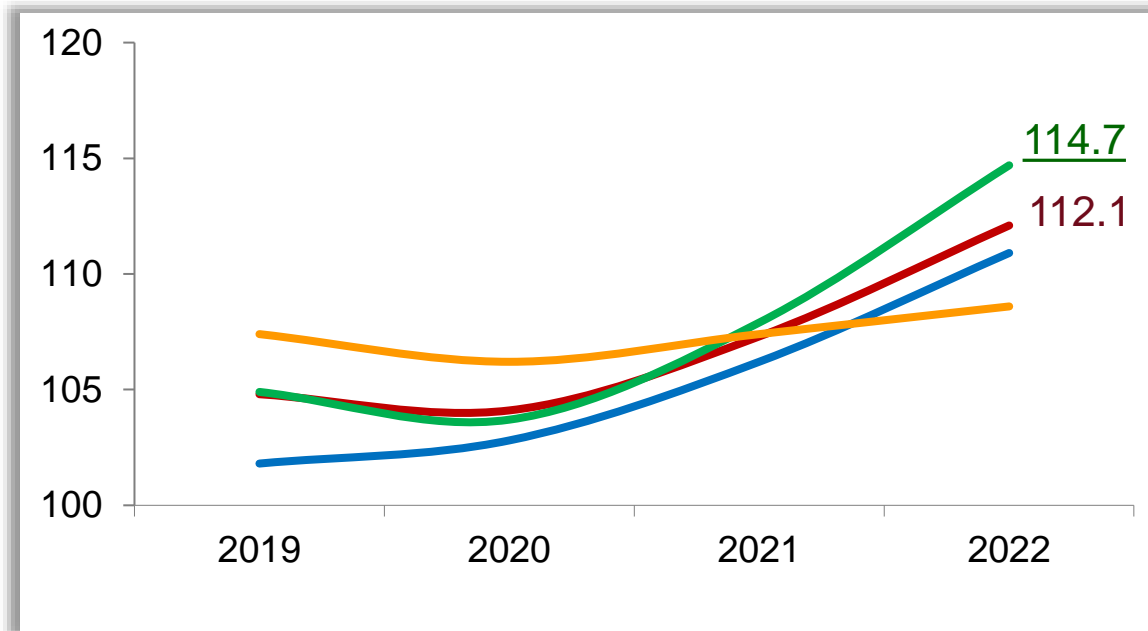
(% of the previous year)





► CPI for the poorest 10%

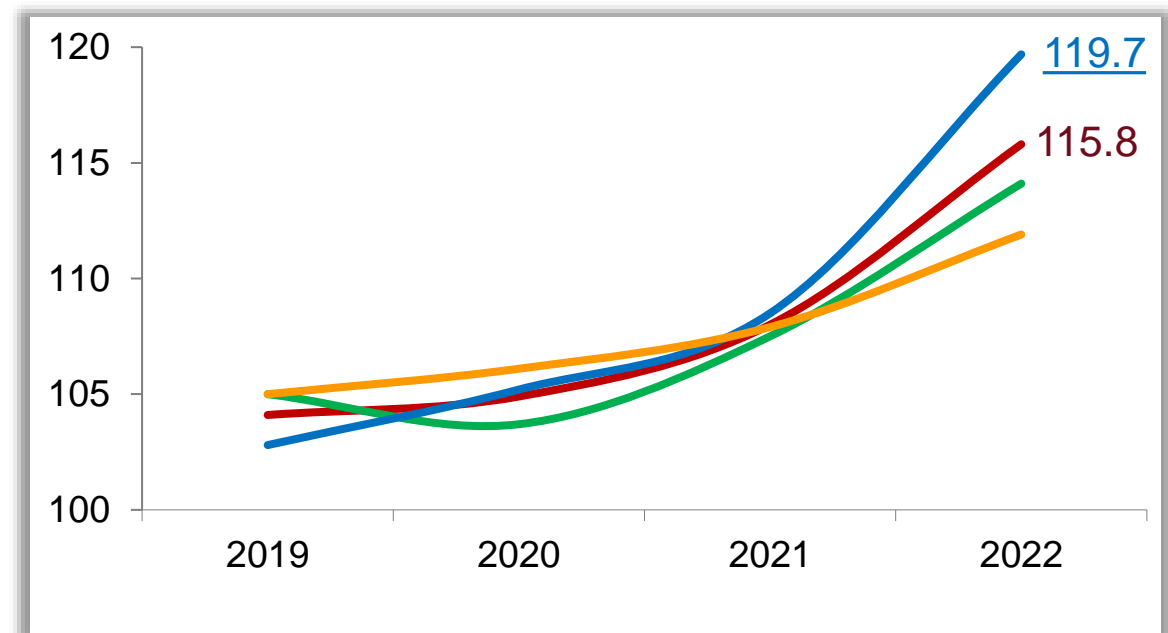
(% of the previous year)

► CPI for the richest 10%

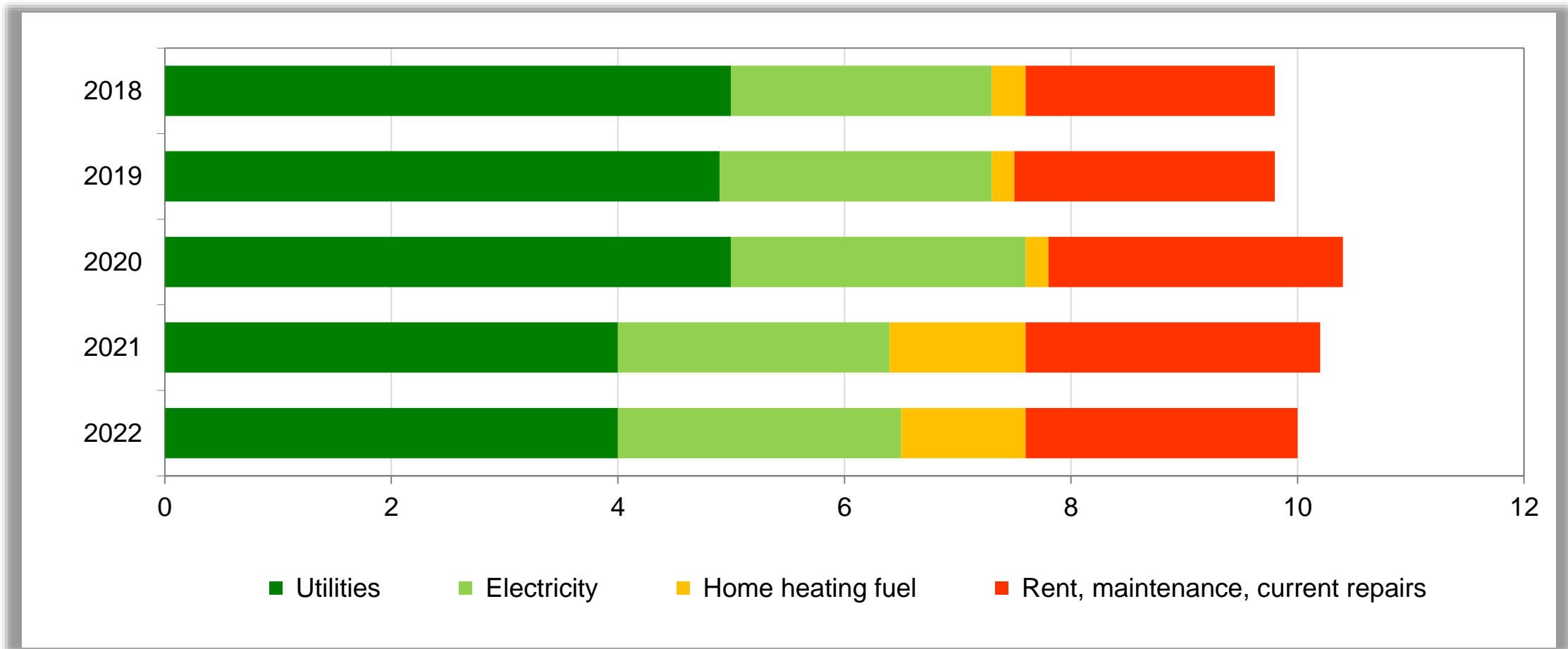
(% of the previous year)





▶ Household expenditure on housing

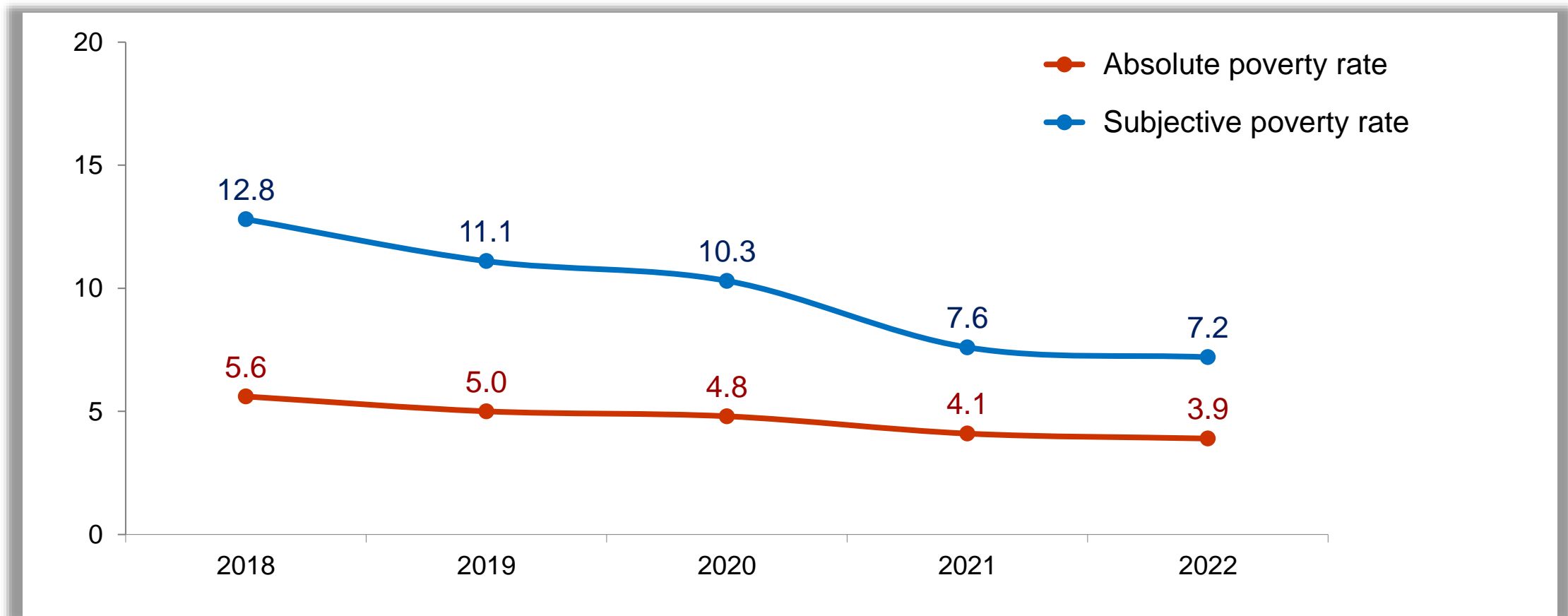
(% of the total consumption expenditure)
