Financing of the operation of the TIRExB and the TIR Secretariat for 2024 – transfer of the amount.

Dear Mr Li,

Thank you for your letter ref.: UNECE/ 2023/ TRANS/ 90, and I have taken due note:

- of Annex 1 to the UNECE-IRU agreement for 2023—2025 inclusive, concluded on 11 November 2022, which shall be adjusted on an annual basis, through an exchange of letters between UNECE and IRU, in accordance with the relevant decisions of the TIR Administrative Committee (AC.2).
- that AC.2, at its eighty-first session, held in Geneva on 11 October 2023, approved the budget and cost plan for the operation of TIREXB and the TIR Secretariat for the year 2024, as well as the net amount to be transferred by IRU, as contained in documents ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/2023/17 and ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/2023/17/Corr.1 (ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/165, paras. 23-25).
- that AC.2, at its above-mentioned session, approved the amount of US\$ 2.7 (rounded) per TIR carnet.

In line with the AC.2 decision, and to continue financing the TIRExB and TIR Secretariat even amidst the on-going challenges severely impacting TIR volumes, I would like to confirm that the sum of USD 1,622,242 was transferred to the TIR Trust Fund on 3 November 2023.

According to the prevailing exchange rate USD/CHF applicable confirmed by UBS (0.902971) on the day of the transfer, this sum is equivalent to CHF 1'464'837.48. The corresponding debit note is enclosed for your information.
