



### **IUCN Mandate on Transboundary Waters**

#### Our most recent call to Action for the Union of IUCN:

**World Conservation Congress, Resolution 015, 2020 Marseille:** Cooperation on transboundary fresh waters to ensure ecosystem conservation, climate resilience and sustainable development

#### Supported by:

- Ministry of Agriculture, Hungary
- Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Nuclear Safety and Consumer Protection, Germany
- Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment of the Russian Federation
- Ministry of the Environment of Finland
- Ministry of Foreign Affairs of France
- RECOGNISING that transboundary water cooperation is key for the sustainability of ecosystems, particularly transboundary ecosystems, and the livelihoods of populations living there
- RECALLING the importance of transboundary water cooperation to address climate impacts, such as floods and droughts, to
  avoid consequences of maladaptation and to harness the co-benefits of improved regional cooperation;
- ENTREATS governments to: a. cooperate in developing and implementing strategies and measures, in particular nature-based solutions, to adapt to climate change in transboundary basins;



- WCC-2020-Res-081 Strengthening national spatial planning to ensure the global persistence of biodiversity
