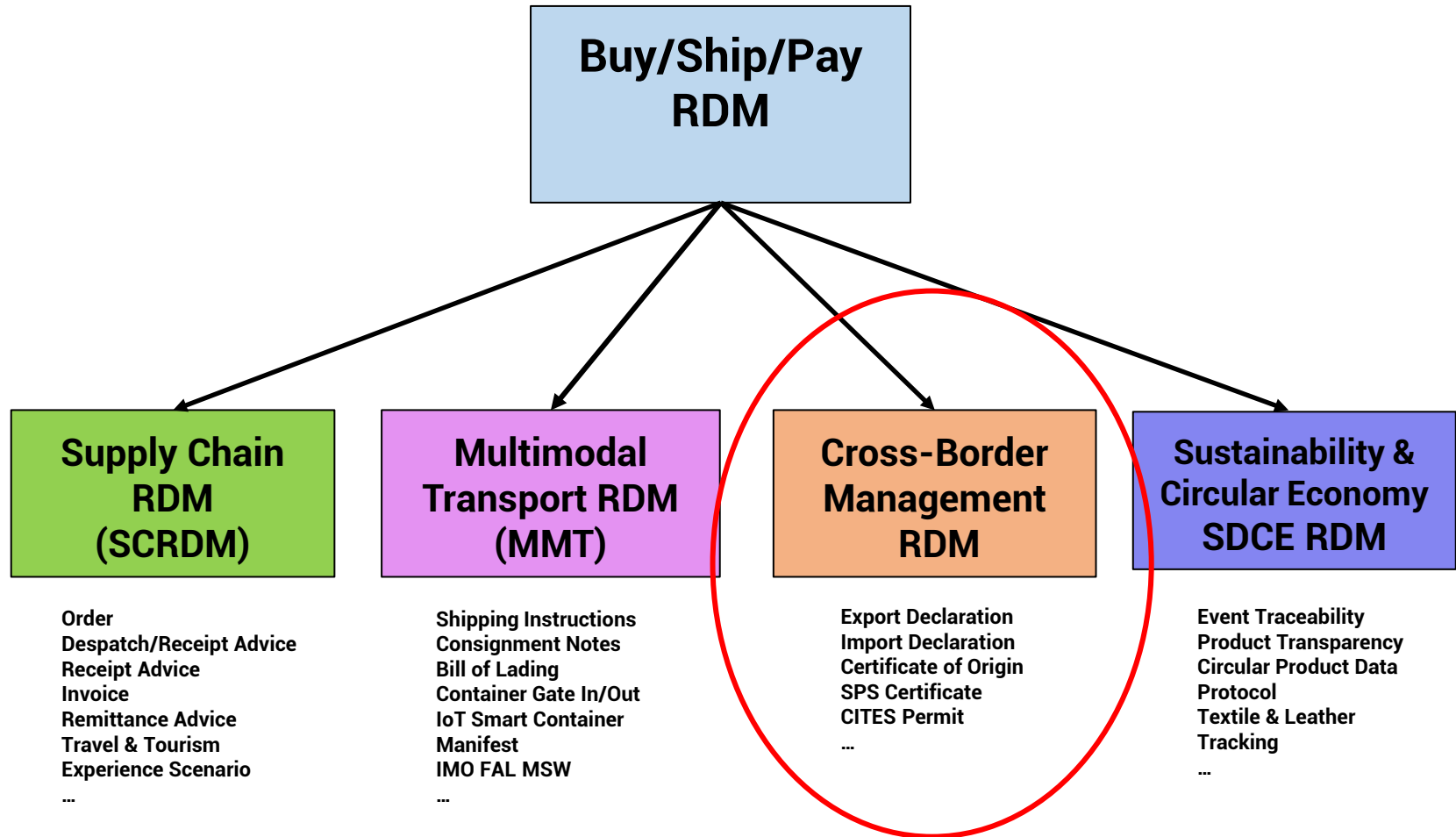

Provide a Regulatory Reference Data Model based on the UN/CEFACT Buy/Ship/Pay Reference Data Model to:

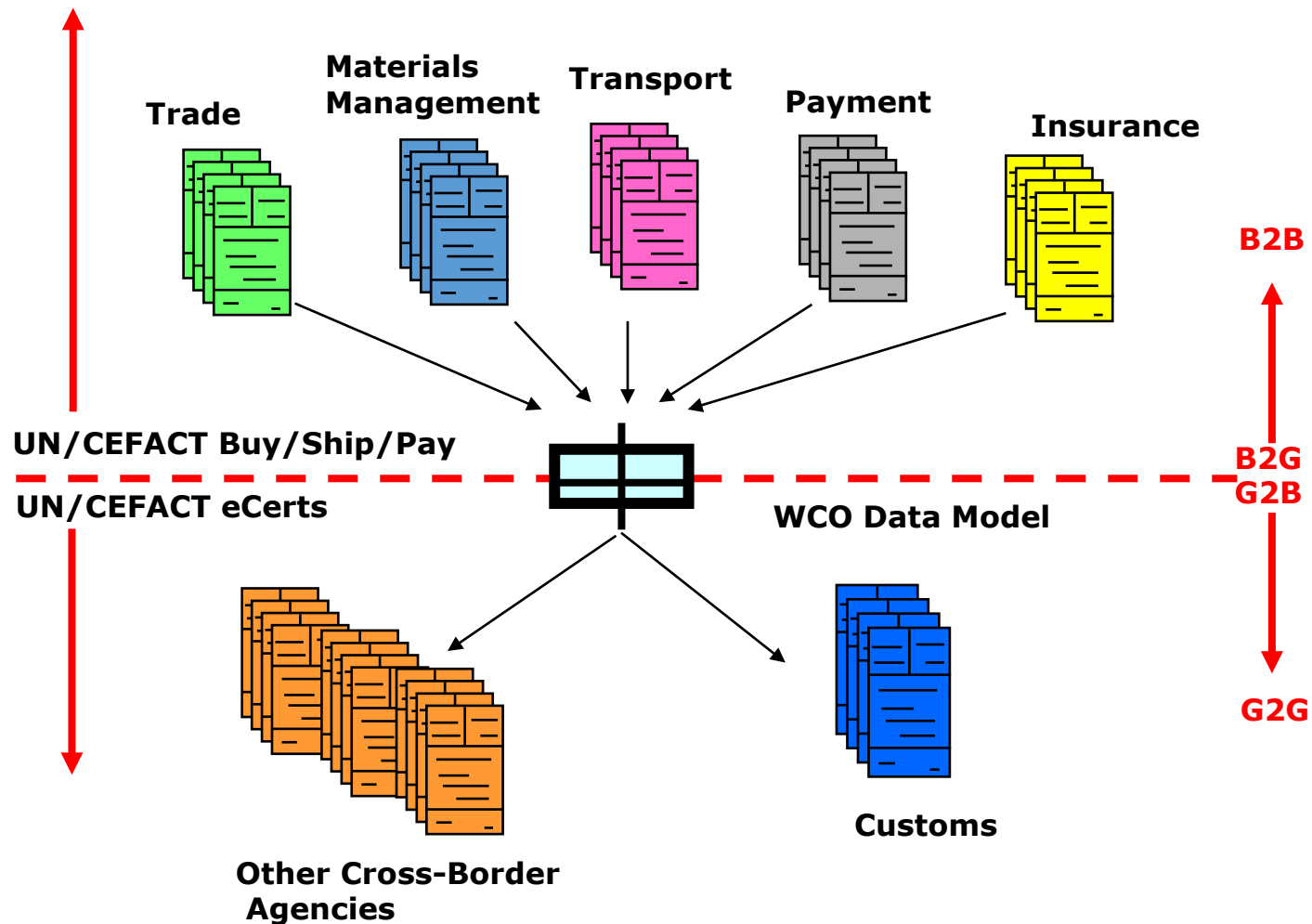
- Assist cross-border agencies to link international supply chain B2B data to national or regional cross-border management data requirements

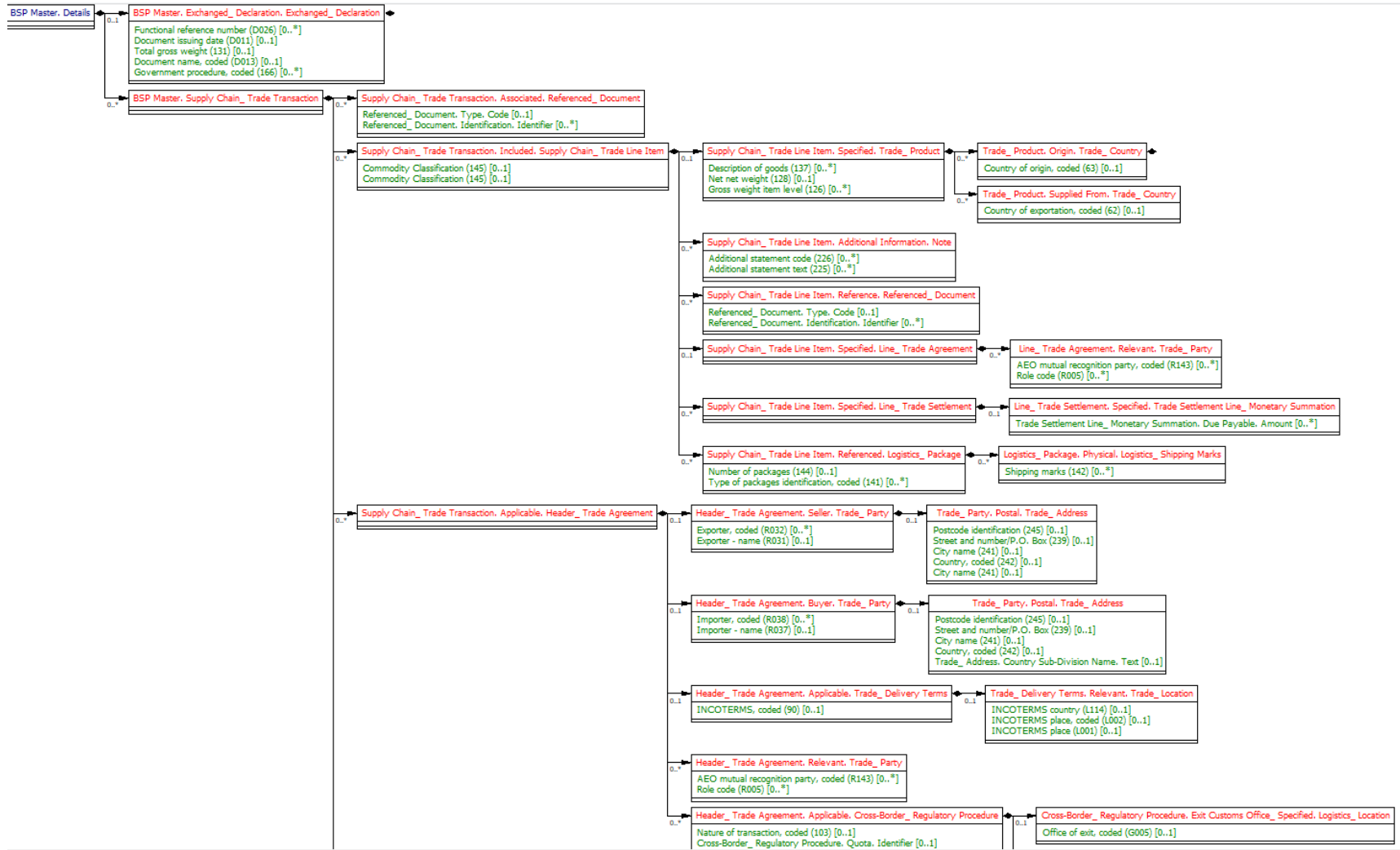




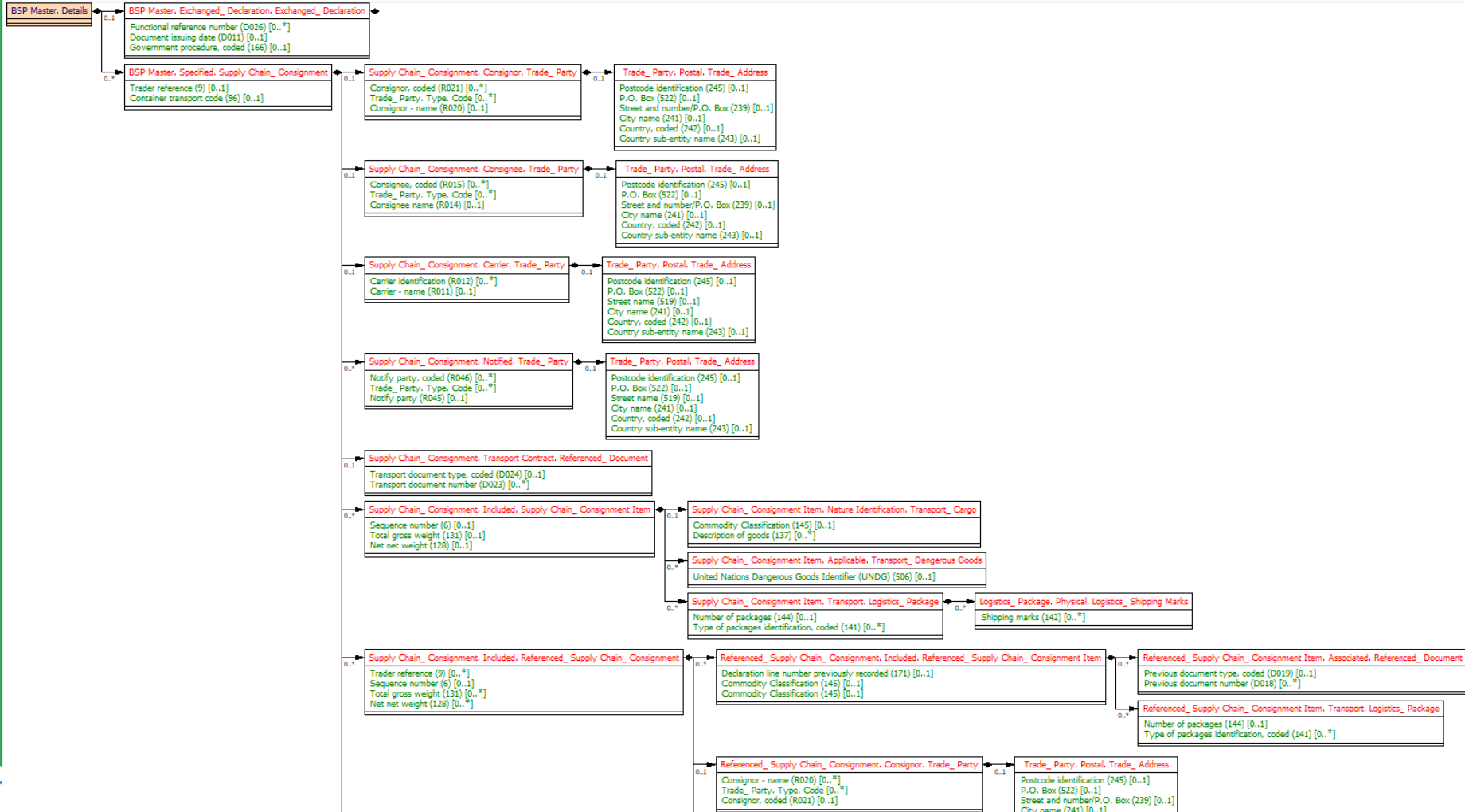
Key Single Window Semantic Aspects

- Public side and Government side speak different languages or, at least, different dialects
 - Affects names and definitions
 - Affects data quality
- Partnership approach using harmonised names and definitions will offer increased quality and mutually beneficial facilitation
- Pipeline provision of data in trusted trader programs
- Primary and Secondary data views
- Managing moving targets

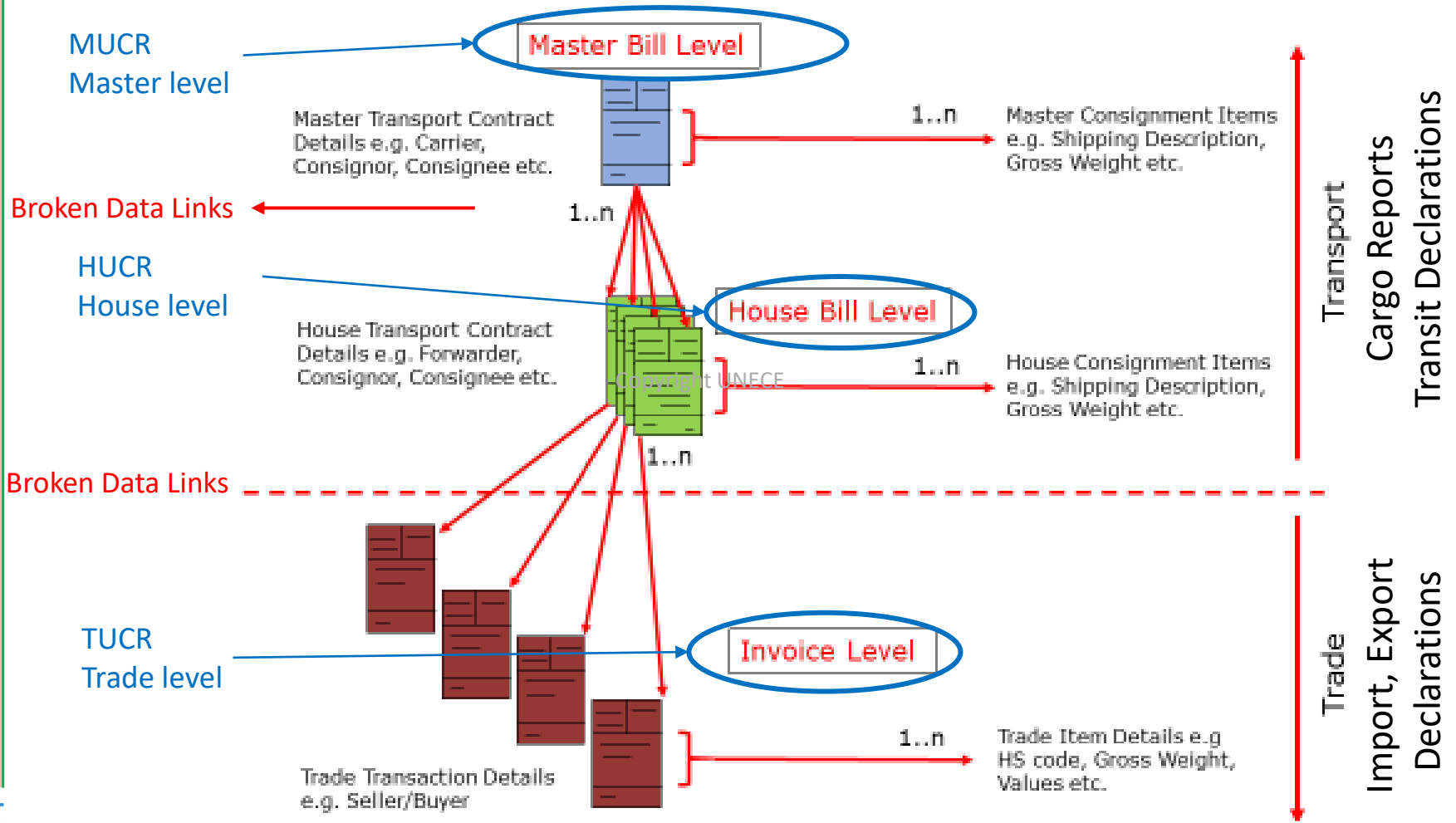
Mapping between Supply Chain Reference Data Model (SCRDM) and WCO DM 3.11 – Trade View

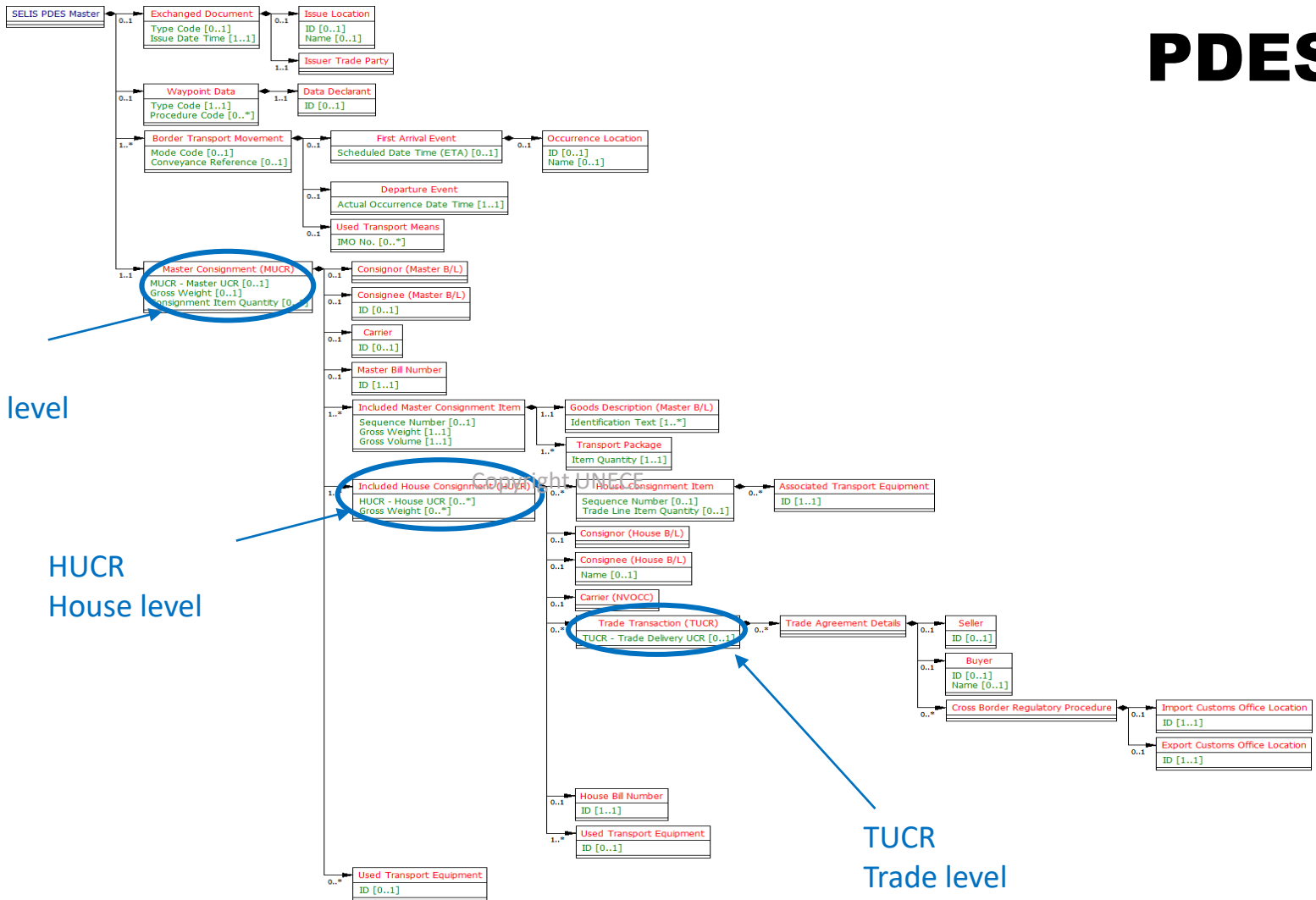


Mapping between Supply Chain Reference Data Model (SCRDM) and WCO DM 3.11 – Transport View



Customs View of trade and transport links (EU UCC)

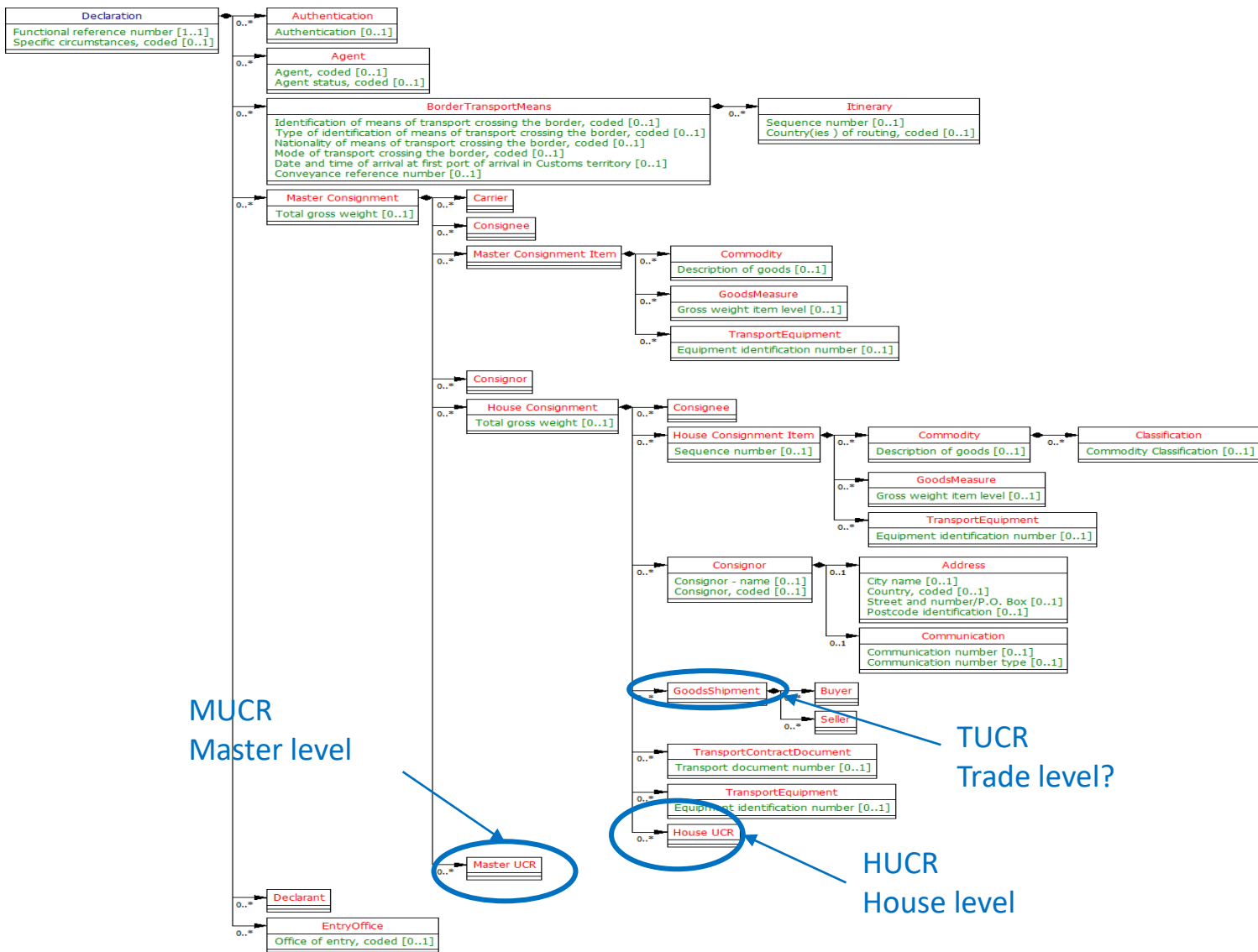

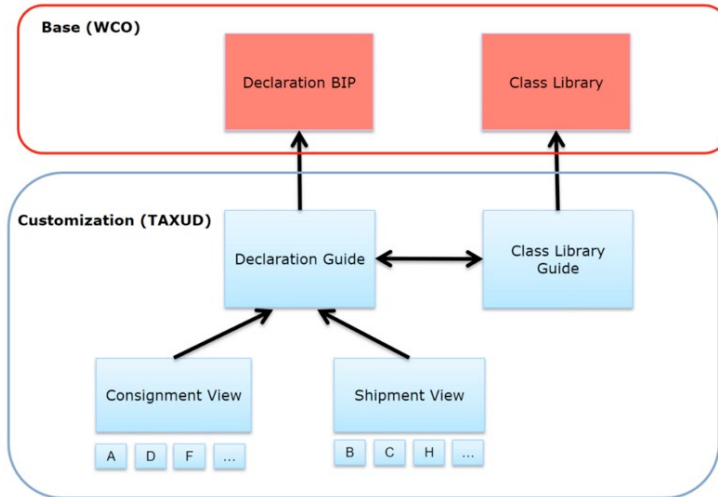

EUCDM analysis process and repository

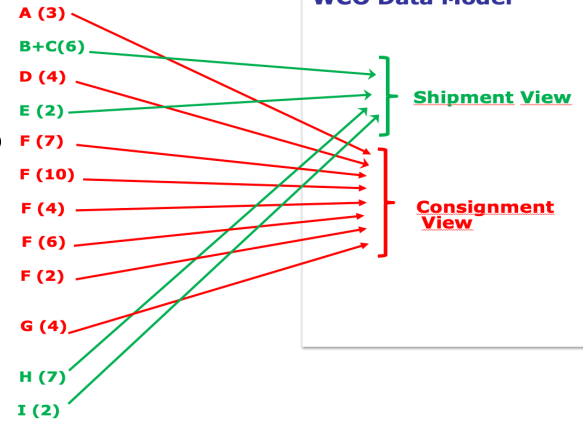

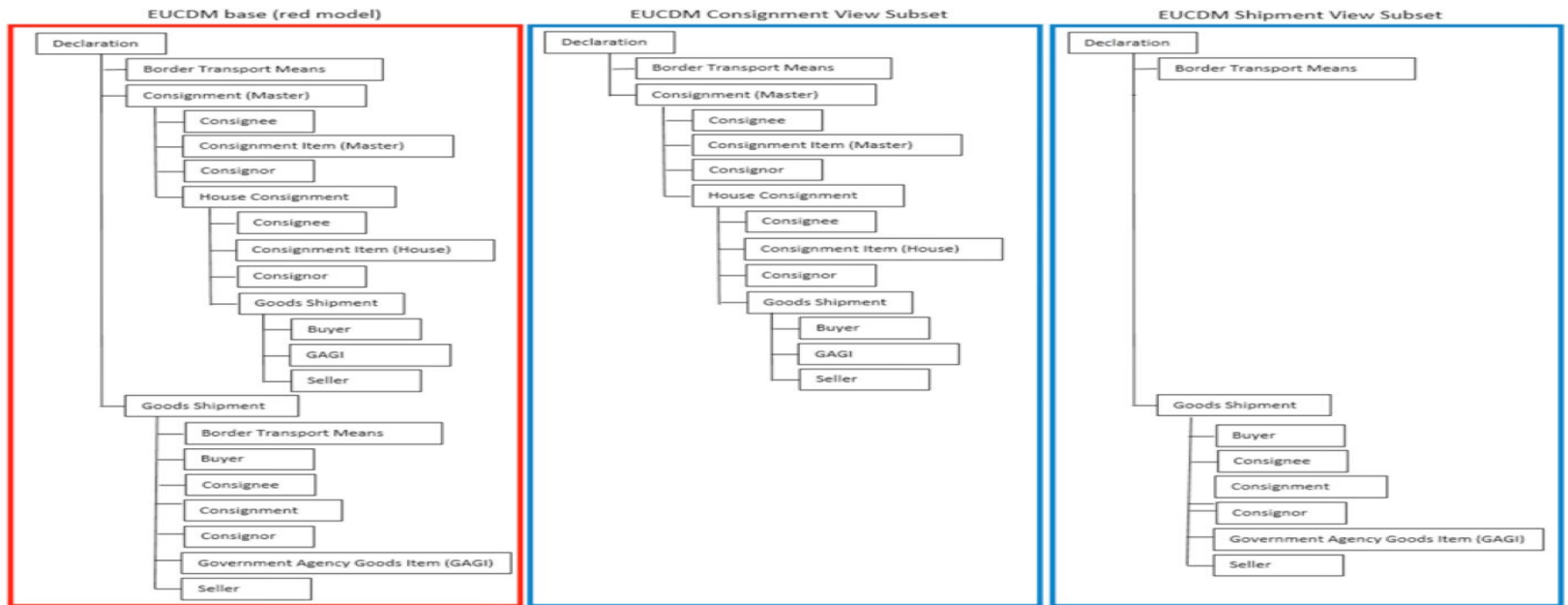
UCC Procedures (57)

- Postal traffic (F40-F45)
- Road and Rail Traffic (F50-F51)
- Arrival Notification, Presentation Notification, Temporary Storage
- Import
- Import (Simplified Declaration; Entry into the Declarant's Records)



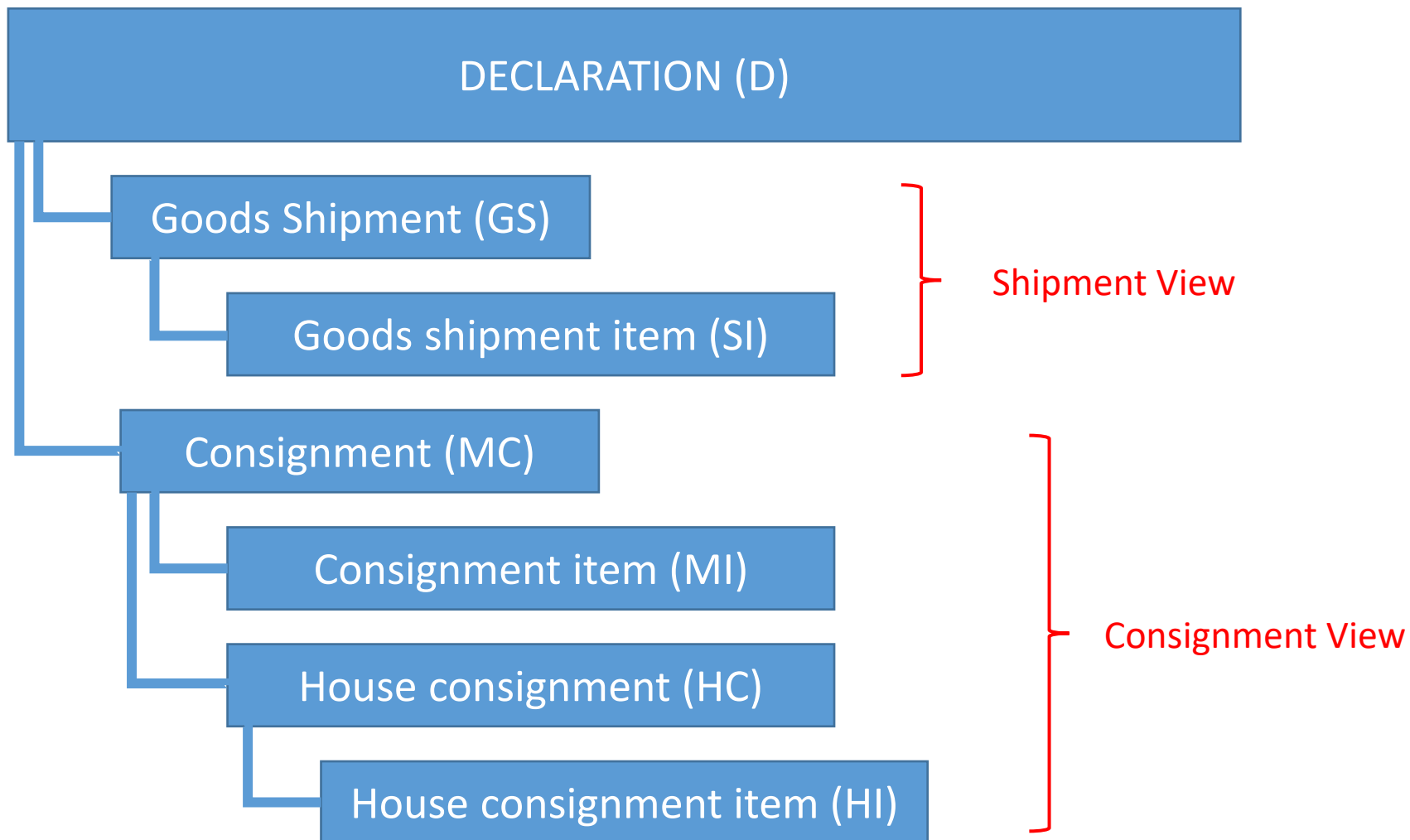
