

Parties to the Convention (52) – newest: The Gambia, Panama, Namibia, Nigeria and Iraq


Countries very close to accession: Côte d'Ivoire, Sierra Leone, Zambia and Zimbabwe

Globalization guided by the **Strategy for the implementation of the Water Convention at global level**






